1 At the end of subtitle E of title III, add the following:

2 **SEC. 360. MONITORING OF NOISE FROM FLIGHTS AND**

3 **TRAINING OF EA-18G GROWLERS ASSOCI-**

4 **ATED WITH NAVAL AIR STATION WHIDBEY IS-**

5 **LAND.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense shall

7 provide for real-time monitoring of noise from all flights

8 and training of EA-18G Growlers associated with Naval

1 Air Station Whidbey Island, including monitoring of noise  
2 relating to—

3 (1) field carrier landing practice at—

4 (A) Naval Outlying Field (OLF)  
5 Coupeville; and

6 (B) Ault Field; and

7 (2) training conducted above or adjacent to  
8 public land.

9 (b) PUBLIC AVAILABILITY.—The Secretary shall  
10 publish the results of any monitoring conducted under  
11 subsection (a) on a publicly available Internet website of  
12 the Department of Defense.

13 (c) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date  
14 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit  
15 to the Committees on Armed Services of the Senate and  
16 the House of Representatives a report on the results of  
17 the monitoring conducted under subsection (a).
