

1 Naval Air Station Whidbey Island, including field
2 carrier landing practice at Naval Outlying Field
3 (OLF) Coupeville and Ault Field.

4 (2) PUBLIC AVAILABILITY.—The Secretary
5 shall publish the results of monitoring conducted
6 under paragraph (1) on a publicly available Internet
7 website of the Department of Defense.

8 (3) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after
9 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
10 shall submit to the Committees on Armed Services
11 of the Senate and the House of Representatives a
12 report on the progress of monitoring conducted
13 under paragraph (1) and the results of such moni-
14 toring.

15 (b) PLAN FOR ADDITIONAL MONITORING.—

16 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days
17 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-
18 retary of Defense shall submit to the Committees on
19 Armed Services of the Senate and the House of Rep-
20 resentatives a plan for real-time monitoring de-
21 scribed in subsection (a)(1) of noise relating to field
22 carrier landing practice conducted above or adjacent
23 to Olympic National Park, Olympic National Forest,
24 and Ebey's Landing National Historical Reserve.

1 (2) DEVELOPMENT OF PLAN.—The Secretary
2 shall work with the Director of the National Park
3 Service and the Chief of the Forest Service in devel-
4 oping the plan under paragraph (1).

5 (c) FUNDING.—

6 (1) IN GENERAL.—The amount authorized to
7 be appropriated by this Act for Navy Operation and
8 Maintenance is hereby increased by \$1,000,000 and
9 the amount of such increase shall be made available
10 to carry out this section.

11 (2) OFFSET.—The amount authorized to be ap-
12 propriated by this Act for Marine Corps Operation
13 and Maintenance for SAG 4A4G is hereby reduced
14 by \$1,000,000.
